

## SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

## Cornerstone Academy



- 1 pair of headphones/earbuds
- 1 plastic extra-long school box\*
- 1 assorted plastic folder with pockets
- 4 bound composition notebooks (wide ruled)
- 2 boxes of 24 count crayons (Crayola brand preferred)
- 2 boxes of washable broad line markers (Crayola brand preferred)
- 1 box of washable fine tip markers (Crayola brand preferred)
- 1 set of watercolors 8 colors

- 24 pack #2 pencils (Ticonderoga preferred)
- 1 pkg. white copy paper
- 1 pkg. wide-ruled notebook paper
- 1 pair student scissors (5" or longer, pointed)
- 4 chisel tip (broad) dry erase markers (any color)
- 1 wooden ruler (inches and centimeters)
  (\*The plastic ones do not work well.)
- 1 bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- 6 Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 boxes of Kleenex/tissue
- 2 pink or white erasers

\*It's important for students to have one long school box instead of multiple smaller ones. This is very helpful as they develop organization skills. Please let us know if you have trouble finding one.

\*Feel free to use any school supplies leftover from last year if you'd like. 👍

\*Items crossed off are things we have leftovers of, so students will not need those this year.

Remember: Back-to-school shopping is supposed to be fun! It's a-okay if they see something they are dying to have (if you are okay with them bringing it)! If NOT, use us as an excuse and say your teachers did not say you need it.
